# Woman clubbed to death by husband

PIONEER NEWS SERVICE ■ LUCKNOW

A man clubbed his wife to death in Sarojini Nagar on Thursday morning. He was arrested by the police and being interrogated.

The victim, identified as Poonam (27) of Kakori, was married to Kamal Kishore of Natkur village in 2010 and the couple had two daughters — Priya (3) and Mahima (one-and-a-half years). Kamal is said to be a liquor addict and it was a major reason for the differences between the couple as Poonam was opposed to his habit. He is also said to be romantically linked with another woman, which was another reason for the discord between the two.

On Wednesday night, Kamal returned home in a drunken state and the couple had a verbal spat before Kamal went into his room to sleep. Early Thursday morning,

## Man, friend thrashed over petty issue

**Lucknow (PNS):** Car-borne youths thrashed a contractor of power corporation and his friend over a petty issue in Gudamba on Wednesday night. Saurabh Dwivedi of Vikas Nagar, along with his friend Bhanu Pratap, was returning home late on Wednesday night. When he reached near Metro Hospital in Gudamba, he found a car on the narrow road. Bhanu got down from the car to move the cart to make way for his car. Meanwhile, another car reached there from opposite direction. "The youths sitting

Kamal again picked up a fight with Poonam without any provocation and repeatedly attacked her with a stick, killing her on the spot. He fled the scene soon afterwards. Around 8 am, a neighbouring milk

in the car confronted Bhanu for trying to move ahead of them and later thrashed him. I came out of the car to save him and was also thrashed. In the meantime, a police jeep passed by and the youths fled the scene," Saurabh told the police.

Meanwhile, the body of a newborn girl was recovered near Mishrapur bus depot in Gudamba on Thursday morning. On being informed, police reached the place for investigation. Sub-inspector Sadhna Rai said the baby seemed just a few hours old.

Meanwhile, a farmer was vendor reached the house and found Poonam lying in a pool of blood. As the news reached the police, they rushed to the spot and informed Poonam's brother Kamlesh about the incident. Kamlesh lodged a

case of murder alleging that Kamal used to torture Poonam for giving birth to two daughters. "Dowry was also a cause of discord between the couple," he added alleging.

"On December 12, my mother visited Poonam's house in Sarojini Nagar after she got a distress call. She met Kamal and his family members Vinod, Dinesh and others. They tried to force my mother to take Poonam and her daughters home," Kamlesh alleged. He told the police that his mother promised to have the dispute settled in a panchayat on December 17.

The police, however, suspected that Kamal killed Poonam as she was opposed to his extra-marital affair. "We are interrogating him," the police spokesman said.

Neighbours also claimed that Kamal had differences with Poonam after she gave birth to Priya. They said villagers counselled Kamal saying he might have a son next. "When Poonam gave birth to Mahima, Kamal's behaviour towards Poonam changed again and he started torturing her," a neighbour claimed.

# President to be chief guest at BBAU convocation today

The full dress rehearsal for the seventh convocation BBAU was held on Thursday. The convocation, to be held on Friday, will have President Ram Nath Kovind as the chief guest.

A total of 210 students will be awarded gold medals while degrees will be awarded to 105 PhD scholars, 60 MPhil students and 450 PG students. The four students who will be receiving the gold medals from the President are Vikas Chaurasia, Mahendra, Richa Verma and Manjesh Kumar.

SSP Deepak Kumar also reached BBAU on Thursday to take stock of the security

arrangements. A route march was also taken out by the police from airport to BBAU.

Meanwhile, the Traffic department has announced diversions which will be enforced at 7 am and continue till the function ends. Heavy vehicles coming from Kanpur side will not be allowed towards Shaheed Path and airport. These vehicles will be diverted to Mohanlalganj, Gosainganj and Mohaan road.

The buses coming to Barabirwa will not be allowed to move towards Shaheed Path and airport via Barabirwa crossing. The same will be diverted towards Mohaan road.

Vehicles will not be allowed

to move from Ramabai Ambedkar grounds tri-furcation to BBAU through the service road and will be diverted to Bijli Pasi Qila. Heavy vehicles coming from Gomti Nagar will not be allowed towards Amausi-Kanpur road and will be diverted towards Gosainganj and Sultanpur road. City buses coming from Charbagh will not be permitted towards Hussainganj Royal Hotel and will be diverted towards KKC and Cantt.

Vehicles will not be allowed to ply from Rana Pratap crossing to Risaldar Park Lal Kuan and will be diverted towards KKC. The VVIP route, BBAU and Risaldar Park will have been made 'no parking' zones.

# Murder case witness lodges FIR against 4 for criminal intimidation

**Lucknow (PNS):** A day after the criminal intimidation, the only eyewitness to the Shyam Narayan Pandey alias Pappu Pandey murder case, Gopal Sharma of Ashiyana lodged an FIR at Hazratganj Kotwali on Thursday. He named four persons, including two henchmen of notorious serial killers Salim, Rustam and Sohrab (brother trio).

Gopal stated that he could not see the face of the suspects trailing his car soon after he left the court on Wednesday afternoon. He said two of the suspects were wearing helmets while the other two also had their faces covered.

"The quarter were on two bikes. On the basis of physique, I identified two of them as Kamran and Farhan of Thakurganj. Also, Farhan has been trailing me for the fast few months," he told the police.


Gopal was with Pandey on the fateful day (2013) when Pandey was peppered with bullets in Aminabad. "I have been getting threats by the opposite party and I was even offered cash to turn hostile, but I turned down the offer," he

told the police. Gopal said he had a confrontation with prime accused Sunil Sharma in the court when he appeared there as a witness in connection with the murder case on October 16.

The prime accused (Sunil) was later gunned down in a police encounter. "The names of Salim, Rustam and Sohrab had also surfaced in the Pandey murder case and they had been charged with criminal conspiracy. The notorious brothers may have conspired to harm me," he told the police.

Gopal, along with two constables and a gunner, left for his house after having appeared in the court as a witness on Wednesday. Soon after he left, he noticed that four persons on two bikes were trailing his car.

When he reached near State Bank of India's head office in Hazratganj at 2.25 am, the youths came close to his car. The armed miscreants tried to intimidate Gopal, who alerted his security and slowed down his car. The securitymen jumped out of the car and challenged the miscreants. However, they managed to speed off.
